Polio Awareness Activity by Rotaract Club of UAF

Symptoms

- Meningitis: Stiff neck, sensitivity to light, and irritability.
- Non-paralytic polio: Fever, headache, stiff muscles, and pain or stiffness in the neck, back, arms, or legs.
- Paralytic polio: In rare cases, the virus can invade the nervous system and cause paralysis.



How do different polio vaccines work?

Oral polio vaccine (OPV)

- Given through oral drops
- Confirms a weakened form of virus, less or three serotypes of poliovirus
- Can be easily administered by anyone
- Helps stop polio spreading between children
- Live virus
- Used as the main preventative treatment against polio

Inactivated polio vaccine (IPV)

- Given through injection
- Contains inactivated strains of all three types of wild poliovirus
- Needs to be administered by a trained health worker
- Doesn't stop polio spreading between children
- Over five times more expensive than OPV
- Used with OPV to provide further protection from polio

Polio

Causes :

Polio is caused by 1 of 3 types of the poliovirus. It often spreads due to contact with infected feces. This often happens from poor handwashing. It can also happen from eating or drinking contaminated food or water. It can also be spread when an infected person coughs or sneezes infected droplets into the air.

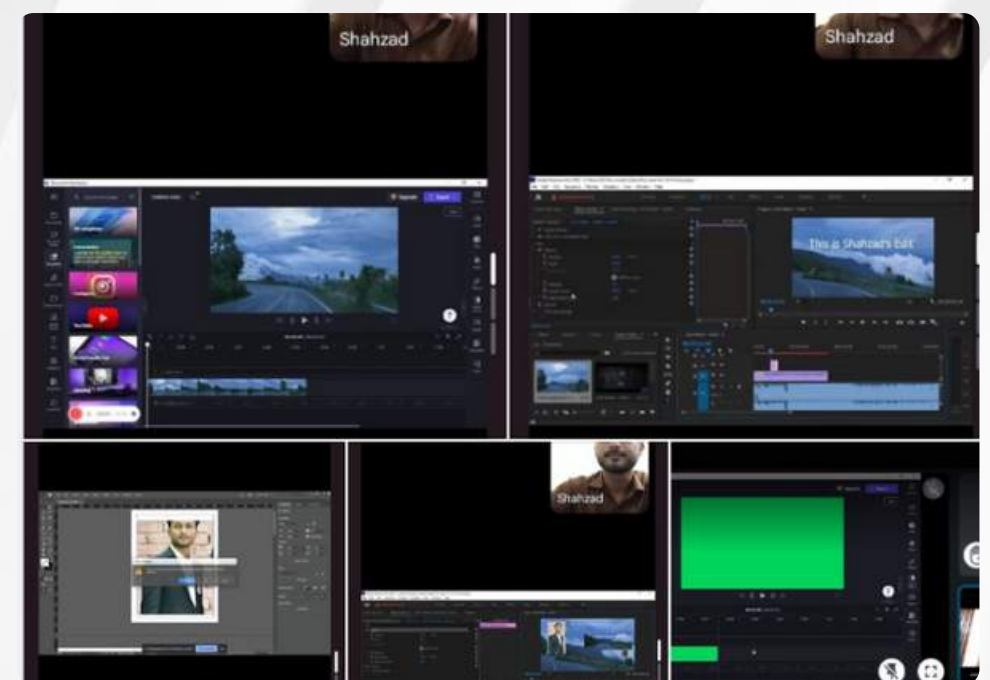

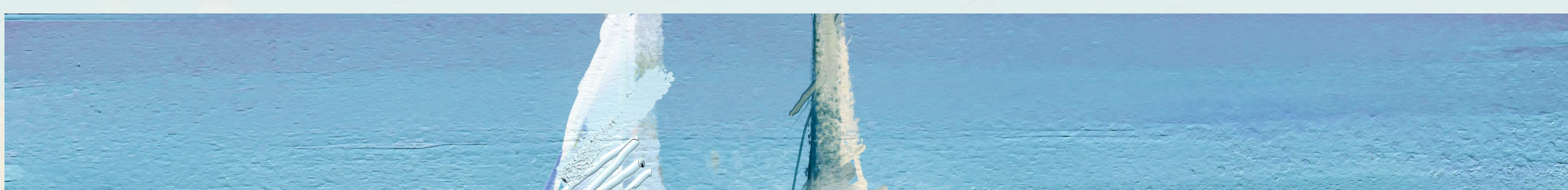
